

Math Recovery Specialists are invited to become SNAP Facilitators



This one-day course prepares Math Recovery Numeracy Specialists to delivery the two-day, SNAP™ Teacher course that allows teachers to grow in pedagogical content knowledge of number while using an individualized assessment tool for determining student need in the various aspects of number. Following course completion, facilitators may lead primary grades teachers to compile individual student data for learning and to establish a class profile which typically reveals a range of readiness and can be used to inform instruction within the core math program.

- SNAP™ teacher materials and handbook with black-line masters
- 25 SNAP™ assessment folders
- A canvas carrying case screened with the SNAP™ logo
